Guidelines for submitting an abstract:

Abstract submission due date is by **5PM Friday, October 14, 2022**. Participants will be notified of acceptance as soon as possible after this deadline. All accepted poster presenters must print out their posters following IAFP formatting* guidelines. Additional information available at <http://safefood.arizona.edu/conference>

- To ensure broad participation, each attendee may submit no more than two abstracts for the poster session. Only a single poster will be accepted for each student or staff member
- The student or staff presenter must be an author on the poster and should be co- author for posters which are to be considered for awards. *Students, please make sure your principal investigator (PI) reviews your abstract prior to submission and is cc'd on the email with your abstract submission.*
- If you are UArizona student or staff member who would like to be considered for the poster award, please indicate this in your email submission. Award presentations will be held on October 27.
- Submissions should include the poster title, names of all authors in order and indicate the presenting author.
- Abstracts are limited to 300 words maximum and should be formatted for inclusion in Proceedings. Do not use all capital letters and be sure to italicize all Latin names. In your abstract, include separate sections for Introduction, Purpose, Methods, Results, and Significance, where the most information should be included in the Methods and Results sections (*based on International Association for Food Protection [Instructions for Preparing Abstracts](#) & Poster (<https://iafp.confex.com/iafp/2023/abstracts/cfp.cgi>) * guidelines*).
- All correspondence regarding abstract submission will be returned to the email address from which the initial submission is received and should be the presenting author's official UArizona email address (with PI cc'd for student poster abstract submissions).
- Abstracts and all accepted posters must be submitted in English.
- You will be presenting your poster in-person, and hang up your poster in the designated display area between 2:15-2:30PM at the DoubleTree – Reid Park, 445 S. Alvernon Way, Tucson, AZ 85711
